Environmental improvements

There are two garage sites due for demolition within the estate this summer; these are 1-6 Rafton Drive and 1-23 Dodsworth close.

We have worked in partnership with Hartlepool Borough Council and residents, to install new grit bins along the bottom of Rafton Drive, and increase the number of dog fouling bins around the estate, especially near the long field. We are also looking at the footpath that runs behind 35 to 54 Clavering Road and borders the rear of Bamburgh Court, to see what options there are for installing additional lighting and renewing the fencing.
