We're pleased the work being carried out by the Environment Agency to prevent flooding on the estate is nearly finished. A lot of work has been done this year to help stop flooding, including raising the banks at Brown's Bridge, improving the flow of the beck to help prevent blockages,

improvements at Durham Road bridge and a new green space to help retain surface water in the Brown's Bridge area.

We also want everyone to play their part in keeping the area tidy. Fly tipping creates all sorts of issues and can make our areas unpleasant places to live. It's also an offence so we need your help to tackle the issue.

Neighbourhood walkabouts

Luke Metcalfe is the neighbourhood officer for your area. He is regularly out and about in your neighbourhood and carrying out walkabouts on estates which you're welcome to join in with.

The walkabouts, also known as estate inspections, involve walking around the estates where Thirteen's homes are located, and identifying issues that might need to be tackled.
